Countries would agree to three pillars:



NON-PROLIFERATION

Stop adding fuel to the fire by ending the expansion of coal, oil and gas production.



A FAIR PHASE-OUT

A fair plan for ending existing fossil fuel production, where nations with the capacity and historical responsibility for emissions transition fastest, providing support to others around the world.



JUST TRANSITION

Fast track the adoption of clean energy and economic diversification away from fossil fuels so that no worker, community or country is left behind.
